




The Catalonian Underwater Activities Federation (FECDAS) and the Spanish Underwater Activities Federation (FEDAS) authorised by CMAS - invites all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in the 2025 CMAS World Cup Finswimming Indoor, Barcelona, organised from 11th to 13th April 2025 in Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain.



















1. Registration process

Please find attached the Technical Notice regarding the registration process through the CMAS Portal.

1. Fees of registration

a. CMAS Fees

For each round, in order to participate, each competitor is required to pay the CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.

• 25,00 € for participation fees by each round (for 2025).

Please note that the names of relay members must be entered during the registration process on the base of individual registration even if they only swim relay and even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on site before the beginning of competition.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card.

b. Miscellaneous

- Fees will not be refunded for non-participation of athletes in races.
- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after the deadline according to the registration planning.

c. Organisation Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (accommodation fee, inscription fees etc.) are paid directly to the organising committee according to the instructions communicated below:

Inscription fees for 2025 are:

- $25,00 \in \text{for each club};$
- 18,00 \in for each relay;
- 10,00 € for each individual distance;
- Fees will not be refunded for non-participation of athletes in races.
- Late enrolments are not accepted as registration is managed by the CMAS system during the registration planning.
- Payment should be made by direct bank transfer.

ATTENTION: Copy of the bank transfer detail must be sent before the 1st of April 2025. Registrations and any subsequent communication will only be accepted when the deposit is confirmed by our bank.

Competition place 2.

The competition will take place at the facilities of Club Natació Barcelona, located in front of Sant Sebastià beach in the Barceloneta neighbourhood.



The swimming pool has a length of 50m, a width of 25 m, ten lanes and a depth of 2m. The temperature of the water is $28^{\circ}C (+1^{\circ}C).$

There is also a 33 m outdoor saltwater pool, where the water temperature is usually similar to that of the sea. During the entire competition, two swimming lanes will be available in the outdoor pool for the athletes to warmup.















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





















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BARCELONA



3. Timekeeping system

Automatic OMEGA Quantum timing with touchpads and backup systems, supported by manual timekeepers.

4. Checking equipment and bottle refills

The judges are authorized to check swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions.

The general control of the equipment (snorkels and immersion bottles) will take place at the swimming pool on Thursday the 10th, from 18:00 to 20:00.


Bottles must be delivered empty to the organization for the control and refilling for the warming up the day before no later than 20:00.

Bottles to be refilled prior an immersion race must be delivered at least 1 hour before the immersion race where to use them.



















According to CMAS Rules, all bottles used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition dates.

Each swimmer must bring their own adapter for charging their bottle.



IMPORTANT NOTICE:

All immersion bottles must be accompanied by the documents that accredit the last periodic inspection.

Extract from the Spanish law for the pressure equipment.

OFFICIAL STATE BULLETIN No. 243

Monday, October 11, 2021

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY, COMMERCE AND TOURISM

16407

Royal Decree 809/2021, of September 21, approving the Regulations on pressure equipment and its complementary technical instructions (ITCs).

Extract from ITC-5

Article 6. Refilling of cylinders from other countries.

Refilling centres that have submitted the documentation established in article 3 of this complementary technical instruction may refill cylinders that are not legally marketed in the national sphere and that come from other countries if they meet the following requirements:

1. The refilling company must request the design documentation or previous inspections when it has reasonable doubts as to whether the cylinder has some type of registration or if it comes from countries where there are no approvals or certificates of conformity and, very especially, when there are doubts about the safety of the cylinder. In this regard, the person who owns the cylinder must prove that it has the following certifications: EU declaration of conformity, certificate of conformity to standards, approval or type registration in their respective countries of origin.

2. To refill these cylinders without subjecting them to the periodic inspection or visual inspection tests provided for in this ITC, the following conditions must be met:

a) The date of the last test must be clearly identified and must comply with the deadline provided for in article 7.1 of this ITC.

b) The owner or person responsible for the cylinder and the inspecting authority that carried out the last test are sufficiently identified, as well as the product to be contained and the maximum charging pressure.

c) The cylinder, in the opinion of the refilling company, is in good condition for use.

:

Article 10. Checks prior to refilling cylinders.

















The Refilling Centre, prior to filling, must carry out the following checks:

a) Identification of the cylinder and control of markings taking into account the provisions of Annex I of this ITC. For cylinders with ¾ Gas thread, if the identification indicated in Annex I.4 of this ITC is not available, it must be placed.

b) Check that they are within the period of validity of the periodic inspection and the visual inspection.

c) Check the external condition of the cylinder and the valve.

d) Check that the valve matches the one identified in the last periodic inspection certificate, or, if no periodic inspection has been carried out, in the cylinder manufacturing documentation.

If a cylinder does not comply with the requirements established in this ITC, the refilling company may not carry out the refill.

5. Classifications

Classifications will be based on times registered by the timing system, results will be complied according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

- 3.1 There will be classifications for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries.
- 3.2 <u>Individual</u>: There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for Senior and Junior, men and women. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.
- 3.3 <u>Club</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will be made also for senior men, senior women, junior boys and junior girls.
- 3.4 <u>National Teams</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will be made also for men, women, junior boys and junior girls.
- 3.5 <u>Countries Ranking</u>:
 - 3.5.1 The Countries' Ranking will be made following points 1.9 and 1.11 by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.
 - 3.5.2 If a National Federation does not enrol its National team, the best two results by club following points 1.9 and 1.11 at each distance, at each category (men, women, junior and senior) will go for the Countries ranking.

6. Prizes


Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.

Teams prizes: cups for the first three clubs and cups for the first three National Teams.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the athletes involved must be at the organising staff's disposal at the right time.



















There will be a special "José Luis Ariño" Memorial Award for the best swimmer by category and gender (according to scoring table based on world record)

During the award ceremonies the athletes must wear the official uniforms of their teams.

7. Antidoping

- WADA World Antidoping Code
- CMAS Antidoping Rules
- Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

Responsibility

The Organising Federation, the organising committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.

Additional Note 8.

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organiser's. Participating teams will be given all information regarding schedule changes.

Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their full equipment at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

2. Registration for events can only made through the CMAS Portal. This is the only way to enter your registration to participate at the World Cup.
